We would like you to sign the slip below to agree to our outline of expectations which will help you best support your child.

- Respond to the communications received via text and email promptly.
- Children should be ready to come into school at 9am.
- The school car park is solely for the use of staff and the school buses. Please park your car at the appropriate areas and walk with your child or allow them to walk themselves using the pavement. No children or parents should walk through the car park.
- To support the safety of your child no parent/carer should enter the inner secure door without first seeking permission at the office. (This allows control of who is in the building at any time in line with our emergency procedures policy)
- Teachers are unable to meet with parents before 9am as they require this time for preparation. If you require to talk to the teacher, contact the school office to arrange an appointment.
- All parents are asked for film/photography consent on an individual basis. It is our school
 policy that no filming/photography takes place during school performances unless it is
 done by the school for distribution.
- Reading bags should be checked each evening for notes, letters, homework etc. Some weekly homework tasks are also issued through Google Class.
- Homework should be checked, signed, dated and a red, orange or green dot placed to signify how your child found the activity.
- Newsletters are issued fortnightly and should be read with your children.
